### Industry licensing information

This course will equip students with the correct qualifications to obtain the National High Risk Licence class LF. Students must apply and pay for this license separately with WorkSafe.

This application must include:

Completed 'WorkSafe WA Application for a Licence to Perform High Risk Work' form

2 verified copies of identification (primary & secondary)

2 passport sized photos attached to the form

A verified copy of your statement of attainment from SRTAFE

Notice of Assessment given to you by the assessor on successful completion of your assessment and

Payment for licence fee.
