### Training support available

Personalised help and expert advice from South Regional TAFE is available to affected workers to help them develop training plans tailored to their individual needs and goals. Workers will receive practical, tailored assistance to support their decision making and transition into training and new jobs.

Based locally at SR TAFE's Jobs and Skill Centre Collie, Training Transition Consultants will work at an employer location to provide a coordinated service.

##### Current Skills Assessment/ Recognition of Prior Learning

- Identify and be accredited for your existing knowledge and skills. If you have existing skills, knowledge and experience but not a formal qualification, then Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) may be an option for you.

##### Skills gap analysis

- Current Skills Assessment helps inform the skill gaps analysis.

##### Skills development plan

- What training activities will be undertaken to help develop all identified knowledge and skills.
